Leeds City Centre West: The Innovation Arc - Supplementary Planning Document

Pre Adoption Consultation

Leeds City Council has prepared the Draft 'Leeds City Centre West: The Innovation Arc - Supplementary Planning Document (SPD)'. This document details guidance for future development and transformation of the 'Innovation Arc' — an area to west of the city centre which is home to many of the city's educational, healthcare, and cultural institutions. The SPD outlines the Council's vision to develop the area over the next 20 years and will help guide planning policy.

The city's 'Innovation Arc' which is equal in size to 175 football pitches, bordered by Woodhouse, Hyde Park, Burley and New Wortley and contains three university campuses, the Leeds General Infirmary, the courts buildings, the Town Hall, Leeds Art Gallery, the city's library and museum, and City Square and the railway station.

The SPD covers movement and connectivity, public spaces, land use and opportunities, heritage and culture and sustainability. It includes ambitions for improvements to roads, public spaces, walking and cycling links, public transport routes, green spaces and buildings. The document will be used to shape and guide future Planning Applications by developers, the delivery of new infrastructure, as well as supporting funding bids.

Proposals include:

- Unlocking 1 million square feet of new innovation space.
- Creating 1 million square feet of refurbished space in nationally significant historic buildings.
- Building two new green city centre parks.
- Developing 200,000 square metres of new and improve public space / realm.
- Investing in active travel and public transport.
- Supporting new neighbourhoods to create around 3,000 new homes.

An initial draft document was subject to consultation between the 24 October and 12 December 2022. This second consultation allows further representations on both the revised Innovation Arc' SPD and the Consultation Statement.

Period for submission of Comments

This is the Pre Adoption consultation (Reg stage 13) of the Innovation Arc SPD. The consultation will run for a period of 4 weeks starting on **Tuesday 27th June 2023** and finishing on **Wednesday 26 July 2023**.
